

3. Water To The Loins – My _____

- **WITNESS:** In the NT the original notion of a witness is exhibited in the special form of one who attests his belief in the gospel by personal suffering. Hence it is that the use of the ecclesiastical term “martyr” has arisen. (*Unger’s Bible Dictionary, page 1369*)
- The word “witness” comes from the Greek word “martureo” which means to “testify.”

Luke 24:48 And ye are witnesses of these things.

Acts 1:8 But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

Acts 4:33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

Matthew 24:14 And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

Revelation 12:11 And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.

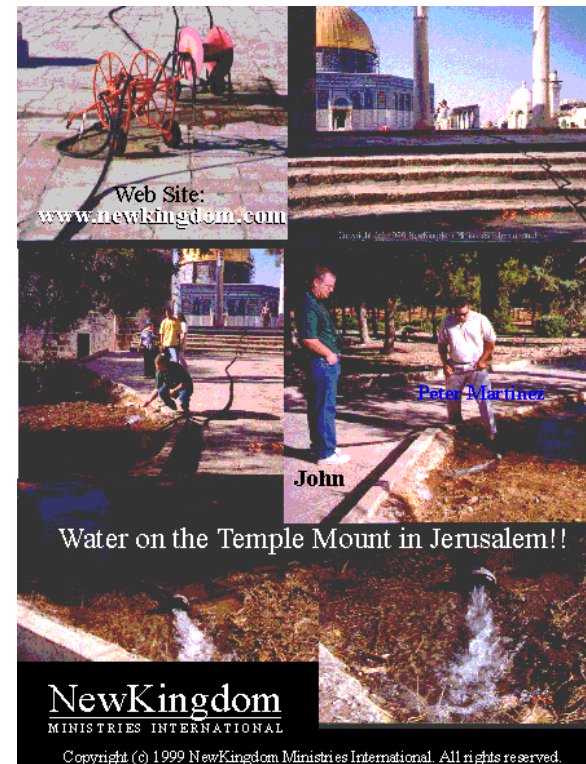

1. Water To The Ankles – My _____

- **WALK** is often used in Scripture for conduct in life, general demeanor, and deportment. Thus it is said that Enoch and Noah “walked with God,” i.e., they maintained a course of action conformed to God’s will and acceptable in His sight. In the OT and NT we find God promising to walk with His people, and His people, on the other hand, desiring the influence of the Holy Spirit that they may walk in His statutes. (*Unger’s Bible Dictionary, page 1358*)

2. Water To The Knees – My _____

- **KNEE:** To “bow” the knee is to perform an act of worship ... Kneeling in prayer was a practice of great antiquity, and references are made to it in both the OT and NT ... Knees are used symbolically for persons (Job 4:4, Hebrews 12:12). (*Unger’s Bible Dictionary, page 746*)

Daniel 6:10 Now when Daniel knew that the writing was signed, he went into his house; and his windows being open in his chamber toward Jerusalem, he kneeled upon his knees three times a day, and prayed, and gave thanks before his God, as he did aforetime.

Psalms 95:6 O come, let us worship and bow down: let us kneel before the LORD our maker.

Romans 14:11 For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, every knee shall bow to me, and every tongue shall confess to God.

Ephesians 3:14 For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ,
